*In 1730 Robert Johnson, South Carolina's first royal governor, proposed to populate the colonial frontier by laying out eleven townships along navigable streams in the interior. Scots-Irish settlers began arriving in Williamsburg Township on the Black River two years later. The area soon enjoyed economic success due to the cultivation and processing of indigo.*

*Williamsburg was later renamed "King's Tree" after a local landmark, a towering pine that had been given the king of England's mark and reserved for use by the Royal Navy. During the Revolutionary War, Kingstree was the site of encampments by both British and patriot forces. General Francis Marion was among those who rallied his troops here.*

*In the years following American independence, the town prospered, with cotton and tobacco as the top cash crops well into the twentieth century. Reminders of Kingstree's rich history can still be found by visitors in its many historical buildings, churches, and homes that remain beautifully preserved.*
