We'll begin at 9:30 a.m., pushing out on the vast, open waters of Lake Moultrie, dropping through the hydraulic locks to the Cooper River, then down the Trailrace Canal toward Moncks Corner where we'll stop for a casual Bar-B-Que lunch. Following lunch, we will continue downstream to the headwaters of the Cooper River and its ancient rice fields on Wadboo Creek. Our outing will culminate at fascinating Old Santee Canal Park.
